 - What are the facility needs of a combined system?

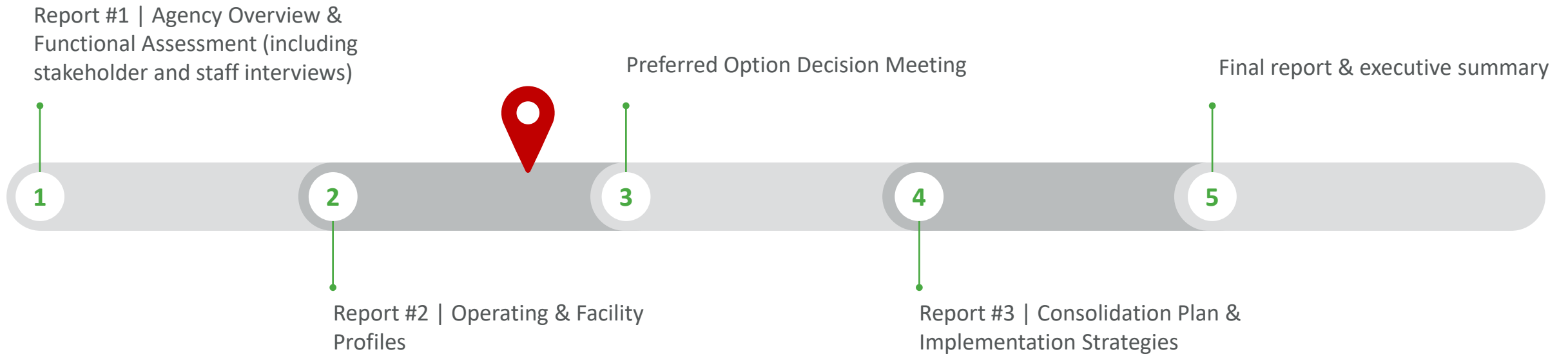

PROJECT GOAL

Develop a **cross-sector, collaborative, compassionate, system of care** for pregnant mothers with a substance use disorder (SUD), their infants, and families.

- Healthy, safe babies with their healthy, safe mommies
- Increase use of best practices across sectors
- Improve maternal and infant health outcomes
- Reduce provider stress, frustration, and burnout
- Minimize duplication and jointly work on collective goals and reduce costs

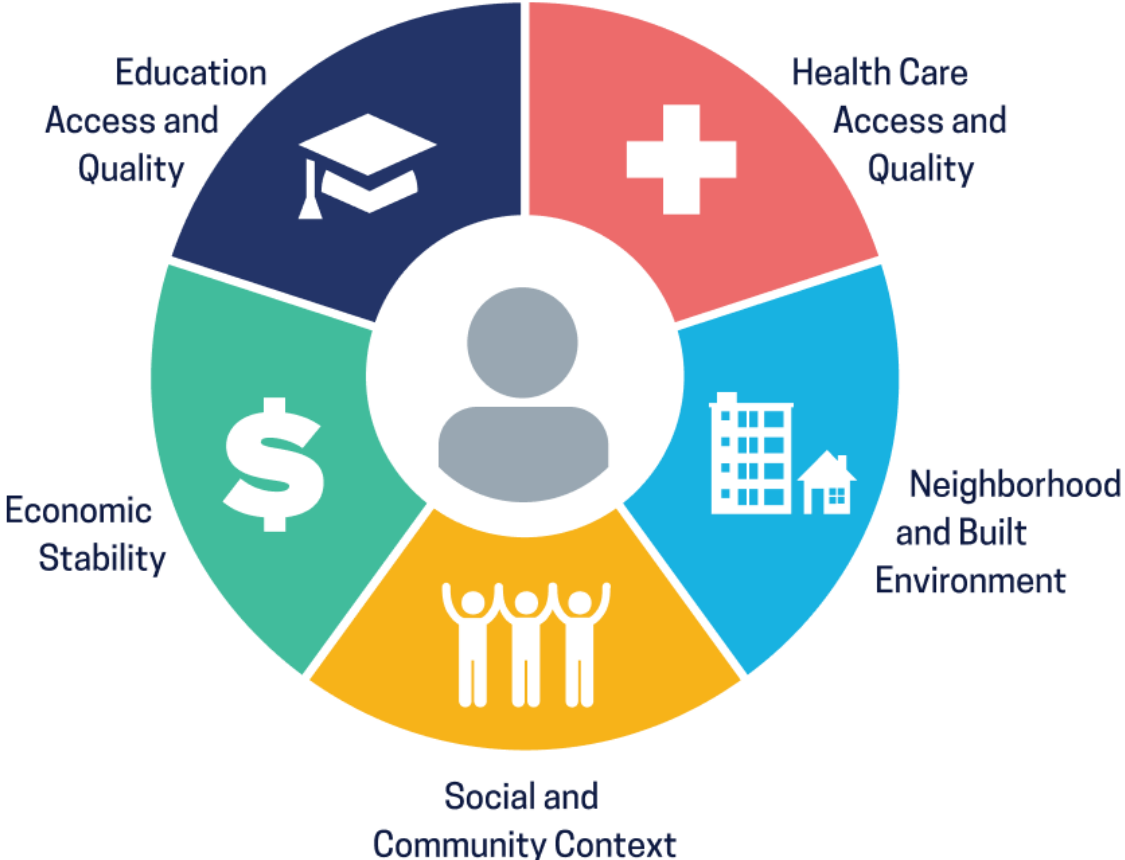

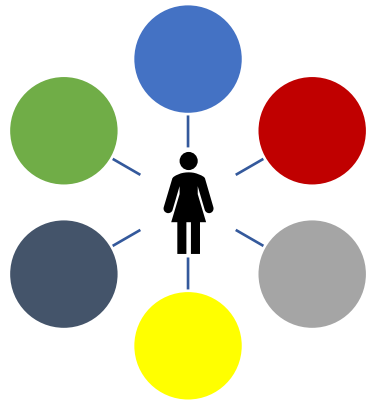
- Prenatal Care by an OB/GYN with specialized training in addictions
- Ultrasound, Lab and Fetal Monitoring
- Medication to treat opioid use disorder in the form of buprenorphine

- Recovery Supports
- Peer Support Specialist services

- Newborn Care



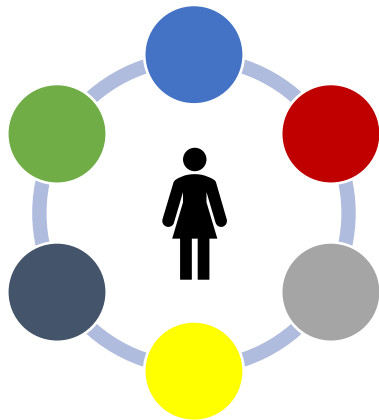
Social Determinants of Health



Structural and legal infrastructure for a collaborative: *(orange) space*



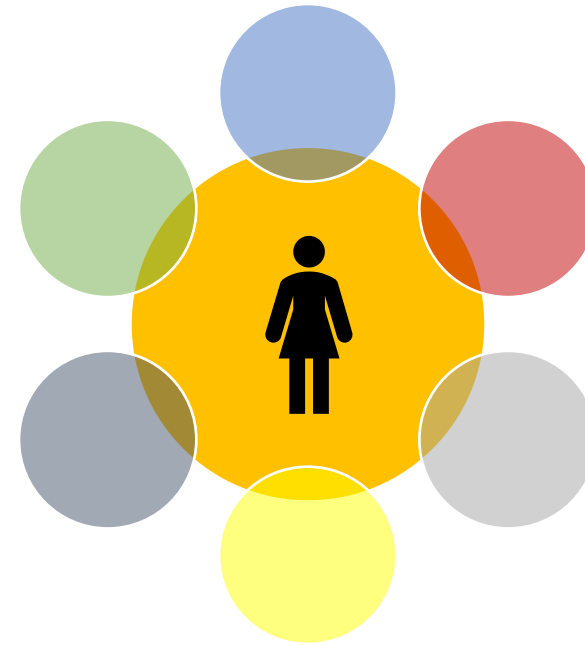
OR

- Providers don't collaborate well

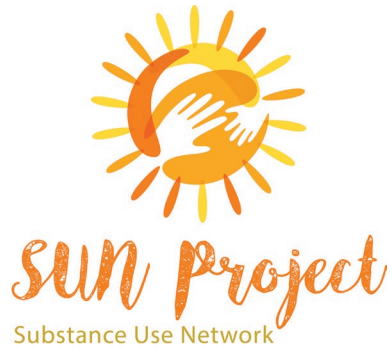


- Some providers communicate
- Patient generally excluded



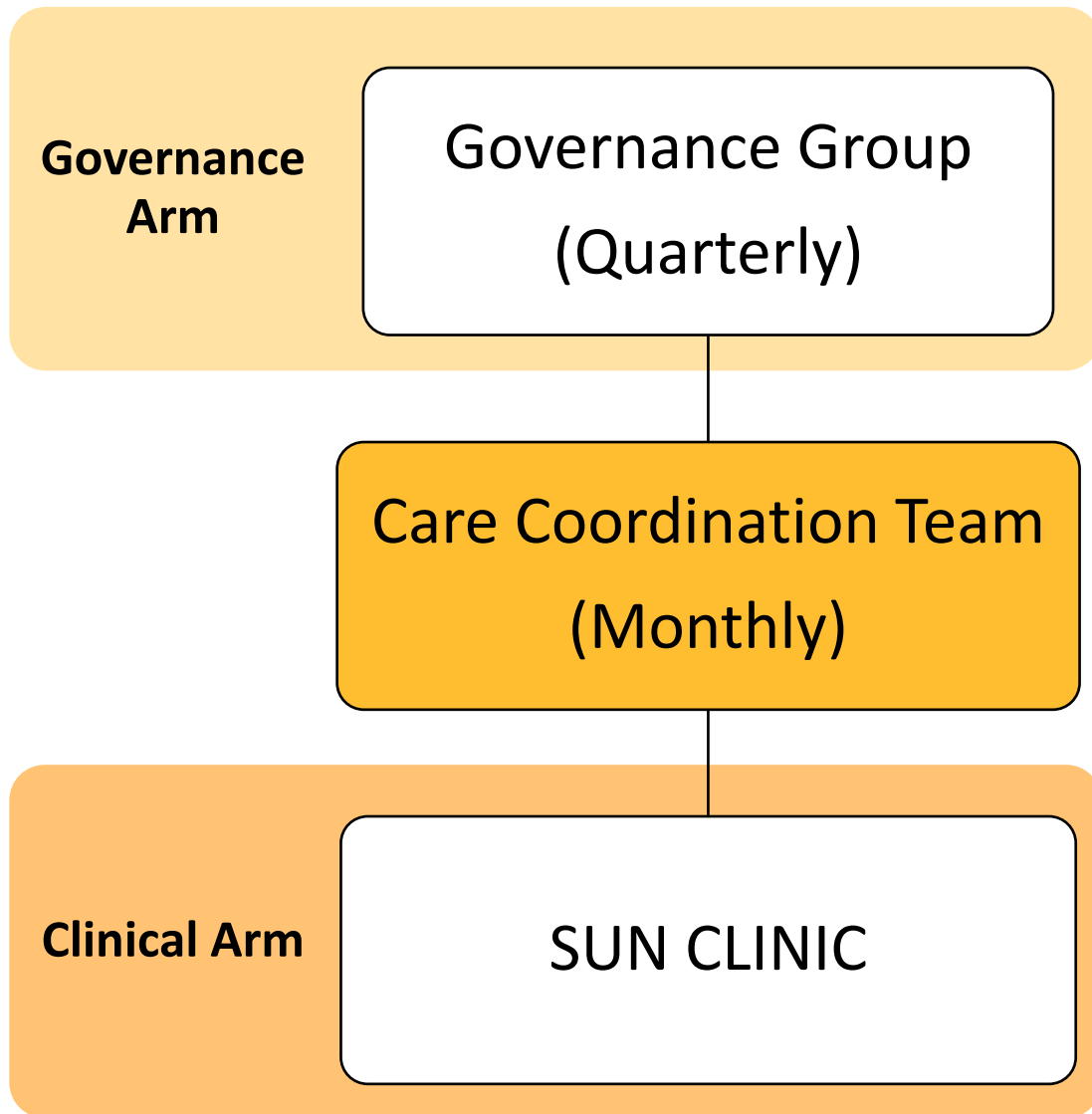
- All providers communicate:

Key Drivers and Innovation:

- Developed using SAMHSA framework and uses **best practices**
- Legal mechanism in place to connect medical providers to each other & to nontraditional partners to address **social determinants of health**
- **Leverages pregnancy positively** (patients & providers)
- Uses Harm Reduction Model
- Believes Mom is Medicine
- Increasing the **Voice of People with Lived Experience**

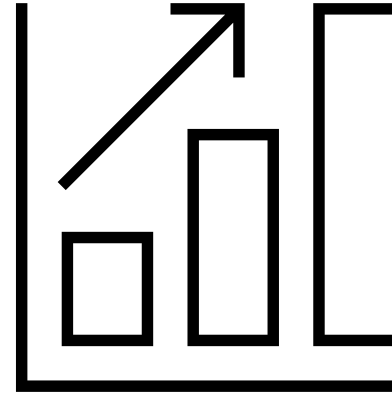


Project Outcomes

- 40 SUN clients served to date*
- 0 infant deaths*
- 0 maternal deaths*
- 91.43% delivered at 35+weeks *
- High adherence to MAT: 81%**
- High retention rates: 95.45%**
- Ave. gestational age: 38.37 wks**
- SDOH needs met: 61%**

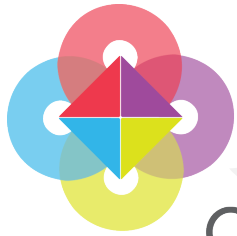

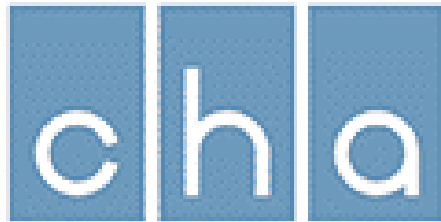
