FY 23-24 Rider Transit Budget

Changes of note:

- Transit Center Repairs/Updates \$500,000 (\$400k Federal, \$100k Concord)
- ADA Transition Plan \$150,000 estimate. \$87,732 5303 (CRMPO)
 \$62,268 5307 (Rider)
- Pay and Benefits increase \$47,228 (\$28k for two position reclassifications)
- Fixed Route Operations cost increased \$37,392 (rate change)
- RideCo & Hopthru Contracts \$47,435; annual costs, no longer Project Fund
- \$21,092 increase in internal Cost Allocations



FY 22-23 Rider Transit Budget

Changes of note:

 We are also using ~\$250,000 in reserve 5307 funds beyond our annual allocation to minimize local cost share increases.



Rider/CCTS Customer Satisfaction Program Plan

- There has never been a formal, consistent assessment of transit service customer satisfaction.
- Currently reply on customer complaints and occasional comments/suggestions. Likely incomplete picture.
- Staff desires to build a customer service satisfaction program to assess current operations and then monitor on an intentional/regualr basis moving forward.
- Task order issued earlier this month to On Call partners. Discussions ongoing.
- Look to have a recommendation at the June CKTC meeting.
